Sector S Effluent Limit Exemption Certification

Instructions for Effluent Limit Exemption for Ammonia as Nitrogen (Sector S)

If your facility is an existing or new primary airport with 1,000 or more annual non-propeller aircraft departures, you may qualify for an effluent limit exemption for Ammonia as Nitrogen. To maintain this exemption, you must:

1. Annual Certification in SWPPP

- Each year, you must certify in your Stormwater Pollution Prevention Plan (SWPPP) that your facility does not use pavement deicers containing urea.
- Use the official certification statement provided below. This language must not be altered, modified, or changed in any way.

2. Signature and Documentation

- The certification must be **signed and dated annually** by a qualified professional.
- The certification and any supporting documentation must be kept in your SWPPP, as required under Section 4.3 of the permit.

3. Change in Deicer Use

- If your facility begins using pavement deicers containing urea, the exemption will no longer apply.
- In that case, you must immediately comply with all applicable permit requirements, including those listed in Table S-2.
