

Connecticut's Species of Greatest Conservation Need and State Assessment Priority Species 2025

This document contains the list of Species of Greatest Conservation Need (SGCN) and State Assessment Priority Species (SAPS) compiled by scientific experts, with partner and public input, included in the Connecticut State Wildlife Action Plan revision for 2025. Below are explanations of the columns in the tables that follow.



COLUMN DEFINITIONS

Taxon: The major species group (taxonomic group) that the species belongs to.

Subtaxon: The subgroup that the species belongs to.

Scientific Name: The scientific (or binomial) name of the species.

Common Name: The common name of the species.

Designation: Denotes whether a species was listed as a *Species of Greatest Conservation Need* (SGCN) or *State Assessment Priority Species* (SAPS) in Connecticut's 2025 Wildlife Action Plan. SGCN are defined by each state fish or wildlife agency in its Wildlife Action Plan and are typically native species with declining populations or vulnerabilities expected to benefit from strategic conservation attention. SAPS are species for which more information is needed to fully understand status and trends to determine the level of conservation concern or SGCN status. SAPS, separate from SGCN, are a priority for additional assessment or survey to address data deficiency.

Importance Level: Indicates level of priority for SGCN and SAPS to receive conservation attention. MOST IMPORTANT indicates species that occur in Connecticut, have a restricted geographic range, and are rare within that range. VERY IMPORTANT indicates species that occur in Connecticut. IMPORTANT indicates species with or without known occurrences in Connecticut or species which have experienced documented declines in Connecticut.
