Approval of Meeting Minutes: Motion to approve April 16, 2009 meeting minutes was made by Virginia Mason Seconded by Joel Severance. All in favor so voted.

Guest Speaker: No guest speaker.

<u>Report on State DEMHS Coordinating Council Meeting:</u> Chairman Austin referred the Council to the April 9, 2009 DEMHS Coordinating Council meeting minutes.

Old Business:

- <u>Statewide Operational Update</u>: Updates and changes to CERT Pending Training, In Training, CERT Trained, NET Trained, and Personnel Trained lists were made.
- <u>Correspondence:</u> Chairman Austin read correspondence received to the group. A letter was sent to the Wilton Fire Chief informing their Category B request was approved.
- Certificate of Appreciation for CERT: Katherine McCormack, Awards Committee Chairperson, informed the group of the committee's recommendations for standards, criteria, recognition, and reasons for a certificate of appreciation award. Ms McCormack stated that the committee recommends three level criteria to receive an award and a committee review of all applications. Ms. McCormack also spoke about the Hartford Police Armsmear CERT team graduation taking place this evening at Hartford Town Hall. She thanked Officer Michael Allen, Hartford Police Department, for being instrumental in the formation of the Armsmear CERT team and Viola Heath, CRCOG, as lead trainer. Chairman Austin will e-mail a draft copy of the award recognition program to everyone and will place this item on the May agenda for approval.
- Statewide Citizen Corps Council Conference Committee Update: Chairman Austin reported the conference committee has been meeting and this year we will have a two day conference with an admission charge of \$35 for both days, \$25 for one day and a vendor rate of \$500 for both days. The Chairman stated he anticipates that the conference attendance may drop from 400 people in attendance last year to maybe 300 people this year. The Conference Committee will meet again on Monday, April 27, 2009.

New Business

- Revision of Grant Application Guidelines: Chairman Austin made a proposal to update the Category B grant guidelines as of April 16, 2009. Comments in favor of the change came from Roy Piper, DEMHS followed by discussion and questions by all. A motion to approve the proposed update with a change made to paragraph 6 was made by Joel Severance Seconded by Sharon Mazzochi. All in favor so voted. Change: with all equipment and exercises. Must comply with State standards.
- Regional CERT Teams: Chairman Austin will meet with the DEMHS Commissioner and others to talk about regional CERT teams, this meeting will be to obtain a clear understanding of the definition of a regional CERT team, activation process, and how to initiate the process. The group had an in depth discussion about CERT team.
- <u>NET Program:</u> Art McLean, American Legion, updated the group on the progress of the NET program. He stated two inserts will be printed Green for OK and Red for Help. The American Legion will present the NET program at Camp Rell.
