Connecticut Statewide Citizen Corps Council Advisory Committee Minutes November 18, 2010

Chairman William Austin called the meeting to order at 2:03 p.m. followed by the pledge of allegiance and introductions.

Public Comments: No public Comments

Approval of Meeting Minutes: A motion to approve the September 15, 2010 meeting minutes was made by Joel Severance Seconded by Dagmar Noll. All in favor so voted.

Guest Speaker: Paul Bancroft and Eric Soucie, RHAM High School, made a presentation to the Council on how the RHAM High School Video Club could be an asset to CERT. Chairman Austin stated that he saw a great deal of potential in what the video club had to offer CERT and that it was possible to make them a response team, (not a CERT team), that could be used for their video capability and news reporting ability.

The Video club has a custom fit fire ambulance and the students are covered by the RHAM high school insurance during the school year and as such, would only be available during the school year.

Sue Prosi recommended that the Council contact Brenda Bergeron, DEMHS Attorney, and go through the system prior to the start of anything. There was also discussion as to whether the students would do the CERT basic training and also if they would be issued backpacks.

<u>Report on State DEMHS Coordinating Council Meeting:</u> Chairman Austin gave an update of the November 18, 2010, DEMHS Coordinating Council meeting.

Old Business:

- <u>Statewide Operational Update</u>: Updates and changes were made to CERT Pending Training, In Training, CERT Trained, NET Trained, and Personnel Trained lists.
- Correspondence: Chairman Austin read correspondence received and sent.
- <u>American Legion NET Program Update</u>: Richard Rampone reported that due to a change of officers at the Post, there was nothing to report as the American Legion meeting was cancelled
- <u>Statewide Citizen Corps Conference</u>: Chairman Austin announced that the contract for the 2011 conference has been signed and that the conference will be held September 6, and 7, at Waters Edge Spa and Resort, Westbrook, Connecticut.
- <u>Statewide Citizen Corps Policy Committee:</u> Dagmar Noll gave the policy committee report. She explained the function of the committee and gave highlights of the thirty percent cap. Sue Prosi, SWRPA volunteered to be on the policy committee to represent Region 1.

• Annual Report: Chairman Austin reported that the annual report has been submitted.

New Business

- <u>Clarification of the Thirty Percent Rule:</u> a motion to move clarification of the thirty percent rule and go to the grant applications was made by Joel Severance seconded by Virginia Mason. Sue Prosi modified the motion. After discussion, the motion failed and the committee went back to the agenda.
- Chairman Austin clarified the thirty percent rule with the Council. The Chairman notified everyone that no more than thirty percent of the entire FY08 grant could go towards equipment and ID apparel. He further explained that as this was the case, the existing FY08 grant application guidelines needed to be revised to comply with this rule. Chairman Austin handed out and reviewed in detail a proposed revised FY08 grant guideline with the Council and after much discussion, further explanations, and changes, a motion to adopt the revised FY08 grant application guidelines with changes was made by Dagmar Noll seconded by Sylvia Dake.
