Joanna Rogalski: The City of Waterbury Emergency Management Director, Adam Rinko, contacted Joanna Rogalski regarding the process by which to recognize and register a new CERT at Post University, located in Waterbury, would like to sponsor CERT. After consulting T. Vannini, REPT Region 5 Coordinator, Ms. Rogalski provided information to Mr. Rinko via email on December 29, 2016.

CEMA (Don Janelle): Mr. Janelle attended the FEMA Region 1 Talk Shop. Said it was a very informative conference call with best practices.

MRC (Katherine McCormack): Not in attendance due to Rich Serino presentation this morning at the University of Hartford. The CT MRC program is a sponsor of today's forum and invited Rich to come here. Katherine has been after the CT MRC units to submit for the Citizen Corps annual report. State Animal Response Team Presentations (SART):

Approved Language of Resolution:

"The Statewide Citizen Corps Advisory council recommends that individual CERT Teams encourage and allow their members to take advantage of State Animal Response Team (SART) training to allow them to assist in setting up, operating and demobilizing pet shelters.

SART will initiate the offer for such training, as long as proper communication and coordination with their local Emergency Management director and Animal Control Officer takes place.

The CERT members trained in SART procedure will need to be members of a specific CERT team and properly activated, furthermore if someone is activated as part of a SART under a CERT activation, that fact should be noted on the activation request form"

Stop the Bleed Campaign:

Bob Freeman, Discussed the possibility of purchasing Homeostatic gauze and tourniquets using CERT funding if supplemental or remaining funding exists at the end of a fiscal year. He also discussed using training funding to hold DHS "Stop the Bleed" training which encompasses bleeding control for the injured, how to use a tourniquet, improving survivability training and fist-care provider training.
