The 2019 Governor's Emergency Planning and PreparednessInitiative (EPPI) exercise will focus on large scale natural gas and electric grid power disruption as a result of cyber related incidents that impact energy transmission and distribution systems resulting in the loss of power generation and other impacts effecting all of New England and across the nation. Long term power outages, rotating brown outs, and communication issues are expected.
