



 Information from WebEOC can be viewed on individual PC's, Mac, iPhone or even a BlackBerry







Enforce Strong Passwords




- A strong password must contain at least one upper case letter, at least one lower case letter, symbols (@, #, \$, %, etc.), and at least one number.
- The password length is a minimum of 8 characters.

A weak password



- Is no password at all.
- Contains your user name, real name, home phone, street address, family name, pet name, or company name.
- Contains a complete dictionary word. For example, Password is a weak password.













House Cleaning Do Not's


- Never post messages in Routine/Emergency
