## **Threat Evaluation and Reporting Course**



The Threat Evaluation and Reporting Course (TERC) trains federal, state, local, tribal, and territorial (F/SLTT) homeland security partners on applying behavioral threat assessment approaches, as it relates to tips and leads, to prevent targeted violence in their areas of responsibility.

The **TERC** teaches students to utilize a **four-step threat assessment model** to identify, investigate, assess, and manage an individual who presents behaviors of concern.

The **TERC** will ensure all participants are equipped with the necessary tools to **empower others** in their communities to identify and report potential threats. In addition, the TERC prepares threat assessment teams to minimize potential threats of targeted violence and to effectively move concerning individuals off the pathway to violence and away from an attack.
