




Threat Evaluation and Reporting Course



The **Threat Evaluation and Reporting Course** (TERC) trains federal, state, local, tribal, and territorial (F/SLTT) homeland security partners on applying behavioral threat assessment approaches, as it relates to tips and leads, to prevent targeted violence in their areas of responsibility.

The **TERC** teaches students to utilize a **four-step threat assessment model** to identify, investigate, assess, and manage an individual who presents behaviors of concern.

The **TERC** will ensure all participants are equipped with the necessary tools to **empower others** in their communities to identify and report potential threats. In addition, the TERC prepares threat assessment teams to **minimize potential threats** of targeted violence and to effectively move concerning individuals off the pathway to violence and away from an attack.
