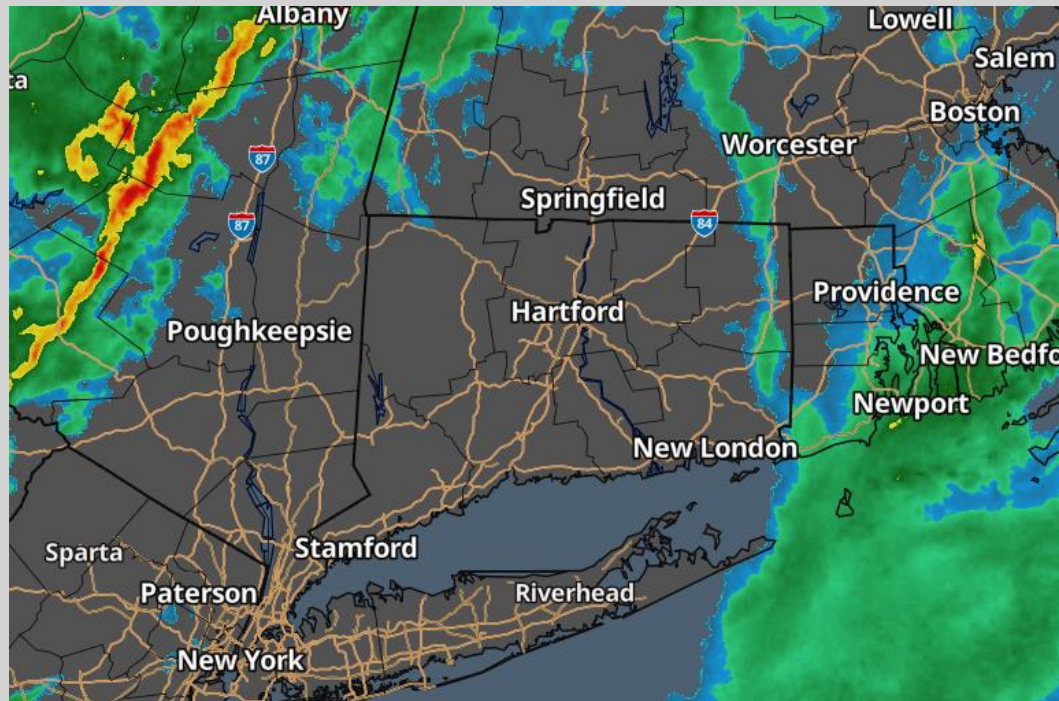

RADAR AS OF 19:45

A line of heavy rain and strong gusty winds are approaching the Hudson River Valley. The strongest winds gusts will occur between 8:30 PM and 11:00 PM when gusts could reach 55 mph.

## Current Watch, Warning, Advisory Map



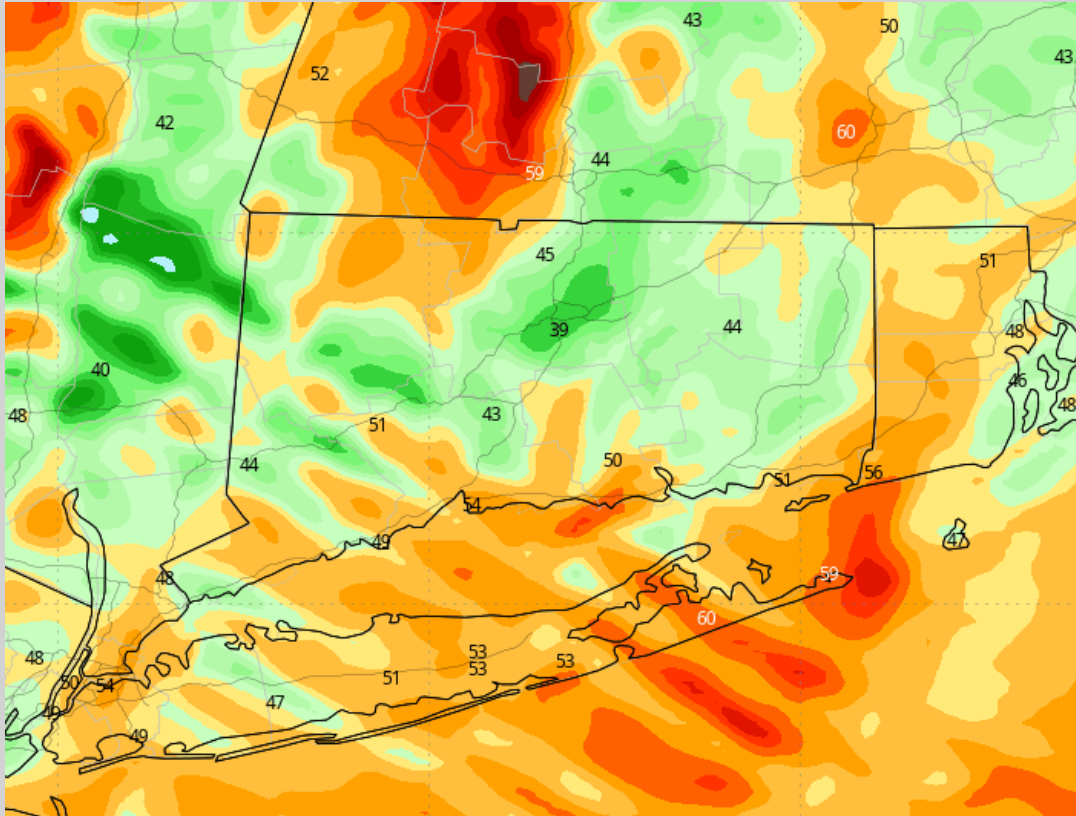
Wind advisories are in effect for all of Connecticut.



# Strong Winds...



Maximum Wind Gusts between 8:30pm-11pm.



The advancing cold front will result in wind gusts of 40 to 50 mph over the next few hours. Isolated higher gusts are possible along the shoreline and in parts of northwest Connecticut where gusts could reach 55 mph.

Strong winds could result in isolated tree and/or powerline damage.

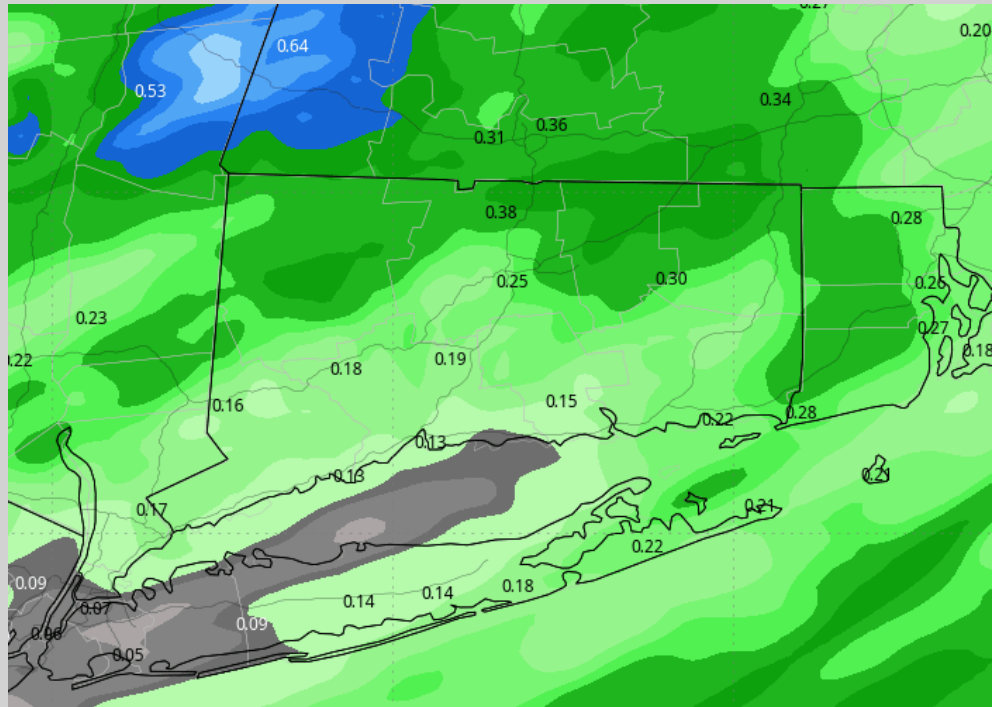




# Heavy Rainfall...



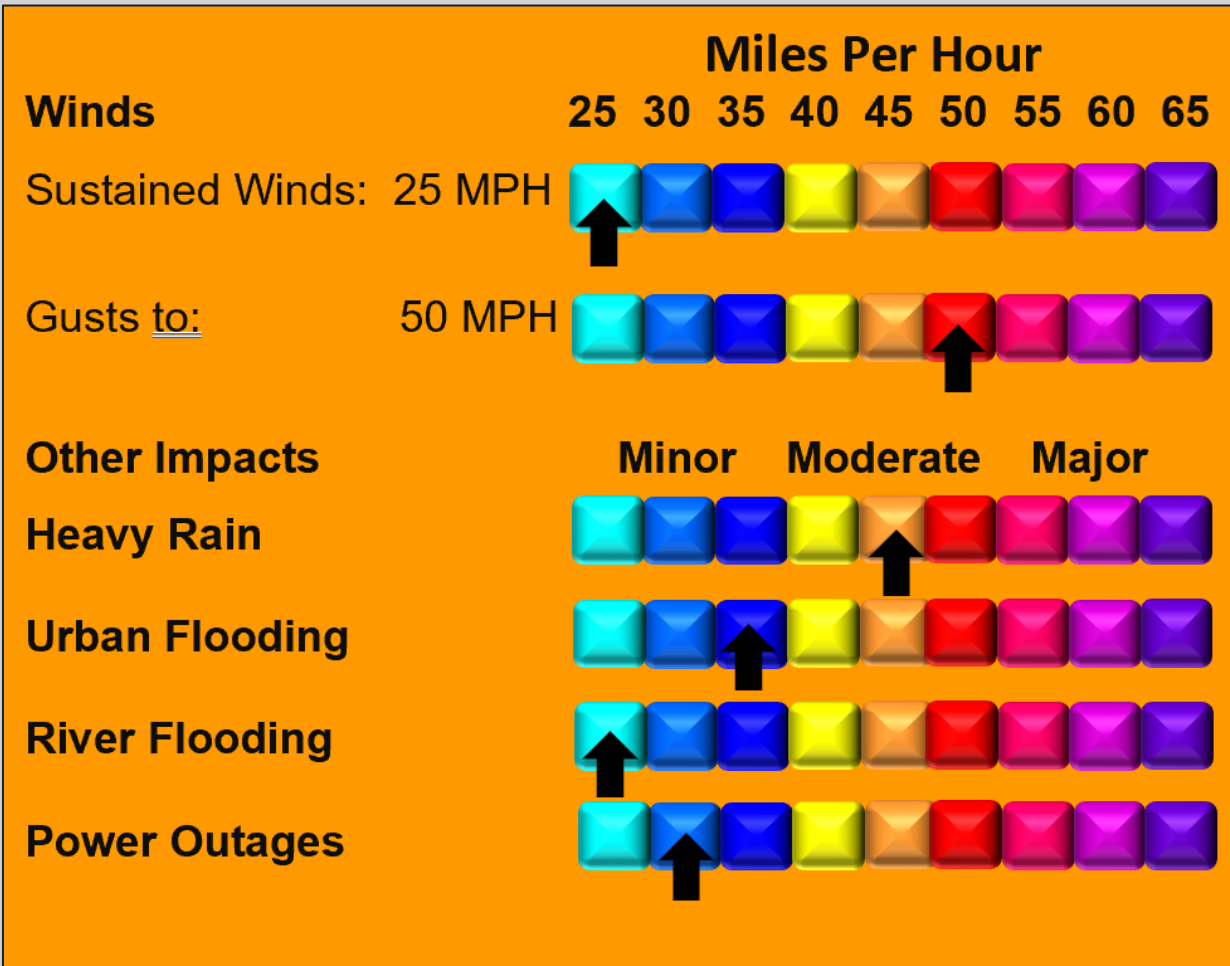
## Total Additional Rainfall Forecast

# OVERALL STORM IMPACTS



Overall storm impacts are expected to be minor in most towns. Isolated moderate impacts are possible in a few towns along the shoreline and in northwest CT.
