### **General Summary:**

OCH and YCCCH staff led group introductions and a refresher on the BRACE grant framework, objectives, and recent accomplishments. The group also discussed the role and expected level of commitment from Coalition members. Subcommittee descriptions were introduced and discussed. These descriptions can be found below, and additional feedback can be emailed to Hannah and Jen. Preliminary Local Health Director survey results were then shared. The Compendium was reintroduced, and we asked that Coalition members share feedback on how to improve the Compendium. The questions can be found below and in the attached slides. Lastly, coalition members shared valuable feedback and suggestions related to community engagement and partnerships, recognizing the variation across CT's 169 municipalities and vulnerable communities/populations.
