Poster Contest Rules

- Each poster must be created on paper of any type (poster board, construction paper, etc.) and must be no larger than 22" x 28" (standard poster board size). Only the original poster can be submitted into the contest, no photocopies. One poster per student.
- Each poster should depict the student's own idea(s), reflecting the theme. Students must use only crayons, colored or other pencils, markers and/or paint (no computer generated photos, photographs, collages).
- Finalist posters, selected by the Director of Health; will be judged by participants of AT-CAVE 2015, who will select the poster that best promotes this year's theme.
- Posters will be judged based on the message of the theme, originality, creativity, and overall presentation.
- The posters become the property of the CT Department of Public Health Drinking Water Section, and will not be returned.
- The top winning poster entry will be awarded prizes at a special ceremony during National Drinking Water Week in the spring of 2015.
- All submittals must be accompanied by the official entry form. The form must be filled out completely and legible.
- All entries must be received, in person or via mail, by the CT Department of Public Health Drinking Water Section no later than November 30, 2014.

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
