TO: Licensed Bulk Water Haulers

RE: Renewal of DPH Licenses for Bulk Water Haulers

Section 20-278h of the Connecticut General Statutes requires that "no person shall act as a bulk water hauler unless such person has obtained a license issued by the Department of Public Health for the transporting of water to a water company or a consumer of a water company where such water is to be used for public drinking water supply purposes". Effective October 1st, 2014, anyone that seeks licensure renewal as a bulk water hauler must resubmit an application by February 15, 2018 on the form prescribed by the DPH here: http://www.ct.gov/dph/lib/dph/drinking_water/pdf/Bulk_Water_Hauling_Application.pdf The DPH's guidelines http://www.ct.gov/dph/lib/dph/drinking_water/pdf/Bulk_Water_Hauling_Guidelines.pdf for bulk water haulers must be met for licensure renewal.

This form http://www.ct.gov/dph/lib/dph/drinking_water/pdf/Bulk_Water_Hauling_Notification_Form.pdf must be completed by the public water system and submitted to the DPH to provide notification when bulk water hauling is required at a public water system.
