SUBJECT: EPA Hosting Virtual Engagements for the Lead and Copper Rule Revisions

EPA will be hosting several virtual engagements beginning in April 2021 to obtain input from the communities and stakeholders for the EPA's Lead and Copper Rule Revisions (LCRR). The goal of the public engagement is to obtain further input on the LCRR, including from individuals and communities that are most at-risk of exposure to lead in drinking water.

Public Listening Sessions


- April 28, 2021 and May 5, 2021, from 10 am to 10 pm EDT
