# **Critical Facility Definition**

ESF12 Definition – a building or structure where loss of utility services may interrupt functions considered essential for the delivery of vital services and life safety of the community

Water supply treatment & pump stations
 Priority Customers - Water facilities that

serve critical facilities and/or large populations




#### Critical Importance Plan, Coordinate & Communicate

- A Refine current list large public water utilities
- ♦ Up to date accurate information
- Ensure clarity and consistency priorities
- Provides a clear, consistent approach statewide to support quicker, more effective power restoration efforts
