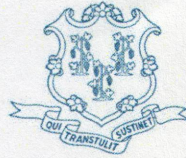

Subject: Application for a Bulk Water Hauler License

On June 11, 2014, Public Act No. 14-178 was enacted by the Connecticut General Assembly stating that "no person shall act as a bulk water hauler unless such person has obtained a license issued by the Department of Public Health (DPH) for the transporting of water to a water company or a consumer of a water company where such water is to be used for public drinking water supply purposes". Each person seeking licensure as a bulk water hauler must make an application on a form prescribed by the DPH. This legislation became effective on October 1, 2014.

The application is here attached and will also be made available on the DPH website at http://www.ct.gov/dph/lib/dph/drinking_water/pdf/Bulk_Water_Hauling_Application.pdf as a PDF fillable application.

Please remind the bulk water companies that you typically contact in the event of an emergency or critical need to ensure that they are compliant with this law and are licensed to operate and provide service in Connecticut.
