Re: Orthophosphate and Total Phosphate reporting

It has been brought to the Environmental Laboratory Certification Program's attention (ELCP) that there have been inconsistences in the reporting of orthophosphate and total phosphate results associated with water quality parameters (WQP) per the lead and copper rule.

Effective March 1, 2021, all certified drinking water laboratories will be required to report results for orthophosphate and total phosphate as phosphate (PO₄) in mg/l instead of as phosphorus (PO₄-P) in mg/l.
