SUBJECT: Bulk Water Hauling Requirements Reminder

This letter is being sent as a reminder to notify the Department of Public Health whenever a water supply emergency arises, as required by section 19-13-B46 of the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies, and to only use a licensed Water Hauler when in need of a temporary supply of potable water for a PWS, and/or for a private well. All bulk water deliveries used for potable water (including temporary drinking water filling stations) must be supplied by water haulers approved by the department as required by section 82 of Public Act 21-121 and section 19a-36(k) of the Connecticut General Statutes.

A bulk water hauling notification form must be completed by the public water system and submitted to the DPH to provide notification when bulk water hauling is required at a public water system. A list of licensed water haulers and the bulk water hauling notification form are found here:
