**SUBJECT:** Connecticut General Statutes Section 25-33q: High Quality Sources of Public Drinking Water

Pursuant to Connecticut General Statutes (CGS) Section [25-33q](#), the Commissioner of the Connecticut Department of Public Health is charged with maintaining a list of all current and potential future sources of public drinking water supply in Connecticut. This information is important to ensure that Connecticut continues to have protected sources of drinking water and that state and local decision makers are able to make informed land use decisions.

All Community Public Water Systems, relevant state agencies and municipalities are requested to review the accuracy of the sources identified in the [High Quality Source List](#) and the information provided in the [Coordinated Water System Plans](#) created pursuant to CGS Section 25-33h.

If you believe there are inaccuracies related to an active or future potential drinking water supply source in either document, or if there are potential additions or deletions to the list, please submit them to [dph.sourceprotection@ct.gov](mailto:dph.sourceprotection@ct.gov).
