Re: Metropolitan District/Manchester Water Department ESA Modification – Glastonbury, CT

Dear Mr. Avery,

The Metropolitan District (MDC) and the Manchester Water Department jointly request a revision to their respective Exclusive Service Areas (ESA's) in the Town of Glastonbury. Both parties recently reviewed their ESA's in response to the detection of high uranium levels in private wells at the end of Cedar Ridge Drive in Glastonbury. This road and several other roads east of the Manchester Water Department's ESA are only accessible via Manchester's service area, and would be best served by Manchester. Additionally, the watershed to Manchester's Buckingham Reservoir is contiguous with this area, and would be best if held as an ESA by Manchester.

Attached is a map with the delineation of the ESA boundary change that shows the current MDC and Manchester Water Department ESA's as well as the requested revision area.

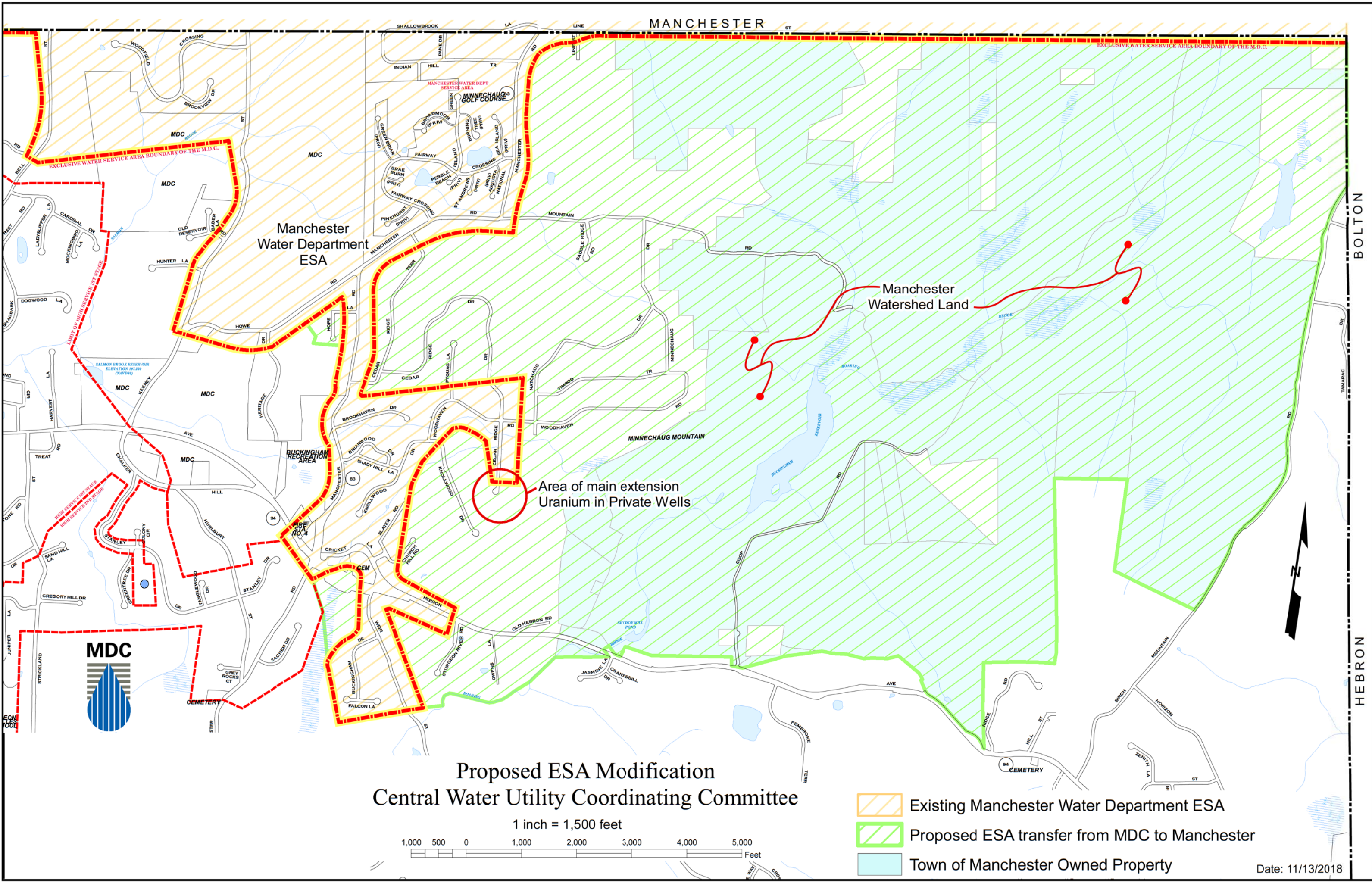

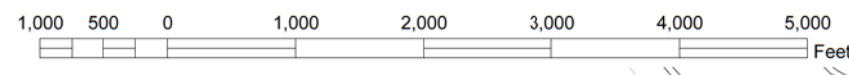
