## Dear Commissioners:

In January 2014 the departments rendered a final decision in the above entitle docketed matter. Relevant hereto, Order No. 10 of said decision required that:

Within six months after the transfer of the West Service and Valley View water systems to Aquarion, REJA shall file with the Departments a request to cease operations as a water company with respect to the Rainbow Springs water system in Middlefield, Connecticut. Until the Departments grant REJA's request and order a suitable entity to take over the Rainbow

Springs water system, REJA shall comply with all the statutes and regulations applicable to water companies and water systems.

The transfers of the West Service and Valley View water systems to Aquarion were done on April 10, 2014.
