CMED 9-1-1 subsidy Funding	B. Morris reported that a letter requesting support for an increase in the CMED Service credit was sent to the John Elsesser, Chair, 9-1-1 Commission. She received an email response from C. Northgraves. A change in the CMED Service Credit requires a change in the DSET regulations. B. Morris requested information on the process of requesting a regulatory change through the Agency (DSET). C. Kelleher researched the last proposed change presented by the Agency (DSET) was in 2020. A regulatory change can also be initiated through the CT Legislative process.	
CMED Work Group Report	Information Sharing on Talk Group Effectiveness S. Savage reported on the successful usage a talk group set up for a large brush fire in Danbury that required a multi-town response. V. Dumas reported similar results for a multi-town/service response to a large fire in Shelton.	
Information Sharing	SWRCC V. Dumas reported that the APCO Communication Training Officer class went well. He reported that Sky Health (Yale -Medical Helicopter) will be operational soon in the southern part of CT. 9-1-1 Dispatchers Conference –NWPS - S. Savage gave an overview of how MECCA (Managers of Emergency Communications Centers) hosted a CT 9-1-1	

	Conference for several years. MECCA is in search of a project manager and committee to put a conference together. A suggestion is to find Dispatchers that would be willing to devote some time. V. Dumas recommended using Zoom or virtual meeting platform for planning meetings. MECCA meets May 24. Hosting a conference has been a topic on the agenda. **Drills/Exercises - Griffin Hospital** is planning an evacuation exercise (electrical fire) **Region 1 - Planning a large scale exercise in the fall of 2023 B. Morris reported that the hospitals across the state are in active exercise mode. She will send the dates of those that have been announced through Region 3 ESF8. V. Dumas reported that the hospital status boards are very effective for Emergency Department staff receiving alerts of inbound ambulances. B. Morris is considering status boards for the hospitals in Region 3. The information is generated from the CMED CAD.
