Add under EMT: “For severe nausea allow patient to inhale vapor from isopropyl alcohol wipe 3 times every 15 minutes as tolerated.” (Consistent with New Hampshire and some scholarly sources)</p> <p>-4.0 A – Burns - Remove the word ‘gels’. Add bullet point with language –consider commercially available water based gel for burns of less than 10% TBSA.
