New Business

- Dr. Kamin spoke about the updated statute on the EMS protocol to be created around applicable patients able to be transported to pediatric crisis centers. Discussion ensued as there are only four sites across the state initially that will be supported. Protocols need to be created with each facility, hours, availability, and patient condition.
- The team continued discussion on creating a best practice manual for peer support. This can include examples, basic outlines, and reference to current departments with active peer support.
 - As a follow-up, Kevin, et al will start to create an outline as to the model and best next steps to vet, finalize and distribute.
- Several examples of successful peer support / health and wellness resources were discussed. This included the engagement of health systems for not only reference material, but support as well to help in training, education, and available mental health / crisis support.
