### **TOP 5 Legislative initiative approved by CEMSAB on 11/22**

- 1. Standing Trauma Committee** – Like the Medical Advisory Committee, Make Trauma Committee as standing committee of CEMSAB.
- 2. Regional Coordinators** – Making them permanent employees
- 3. Mileage** – currently, Medicaid does not pay load miles for intracity mileage. Have Medicaid include loaded mileage in the rates for intra-city transports
- 4. Wording of “Maximum Allowable”** – remove that language to reflect that the rates set by OEMS are “the Rates”: so as to remove any ambiguity when negotiating with insurers.
- 5. Establish EMS as an “Essential Service” in CT**

As other items arise, CEMSAB and the Legislative Committee will evaluate the need to engage on those items throughout the session.
