Duties (as per state regulation Sec 19a-177)

The CT Trauma Committee shall, at least annually:

- (A) review protocols and recommend changes to the commissioner through the EMS Advisory Board; and
- (B) evaluate the status of the trauma system and recommend changes to the commissioner through the EMS Advisory Board.

Proposed Goals for 2019:

1. To work in collaboration with CEMSMAC to provide input regarding the update of prehospital care protocols
2. To continue facilitating the creation of a statewide trauma registry and advocate for information sharing through de-identified dashboard access.
3. To propose and support state legislation that will support the CT state Trauma Committee being recognized as a standing committee of CEMSAB with voting capacity.
4. To build a CT trauma committee sub committee on injury prevention based on the data that comes out of the statewide trauma registry.
5. To support programs that bring hemorrhage control education to civilians throughout the state of CT.
