CT Trauma Committee Annual List of Duties & Goals (2019) Draft

<u>Duties</u> (as per state regulation Sec 19a-177)

The CT Trauma Committee shall, at least annually:

- (A) review protocols and recommend changes to the commissioner through the EMS Advisory Board; and
- (B) evaluate the status of the trauma system and recommend changes to the commissioner through the EMS Advisory Board.

Proposed Goals for 2019:

- 1. To work in collaboration with CEMSMAC to provide input regarding the update of prehospital care protocols
- 2. To continue facilitating the creation of a statewide trauma registry and advocate for information sharing through de-identified dashboard access.
- 3. To propose and support state legislation that will support the CT state Trauma Committee being recognized as a standing committee of CEMSAB with voting capacity.
- 4. To build a CT trauma committee sub committee on injury prevention based on the data that comes out of the statewide trauma registry.
- 5. To support programs that bring hemorrhage control education to civilians throughout the state of CT.
