Re: NEMSIS v3 update

We would like to acknowledge the EMS providers who have worked on the data dictionary code lists – thanks to their help, we have the first hospital and ED codes.

We are providing an update on our conversion of EMS data to NEMSIS v3.4.0. Attached you will find three reference documents (also available on the [CEMSTARS page](#) of the OEMS website):

- 1) **Hospital and ED destination codes** - This spreadsheet gives the data entry code (NUMERIC), name, address, state, zip and other information for acute care hospitals we have transported to in Connecticut, Rhode Island, Massachusetts and New York. The listing includes entries for Connecticut free-standing EDs that we transport to, as well as a generic number for Air Transport landing zones (990001) and for other categories of facilities (999999).
- 2) **Disposition (e.Disposition) fields in NEMSIS 3.4.0** – This table explains the use of Disposition fields and proposed edits; this is the context in which your hospital code and related information collected.
- 3) **Excerpt from the NEMSIS data dictionary** – This reference table includes the meanings of Mandatory, Required, Recommended and Optional.

We continue to work on many aspects of transition to collection of EMS data in a new central site. Although we cannot have everything ready at once, we will continue to give you updates throughout the process.

- ✓ manual submitters can also login and see what happened to their data submissions. 2017 Data is submitted to the central site usually *within 30 days of the event*.
- ✓ [Ann Kloter](#) is contacted directly for any concerns.
- ✓ you will continue to check the CEMSTARS page of the OEMS website for additional information.

We are awaiting additional database tools for both EMS agencies and for OEMS. Additional code lists and information will be provided as it becomes available.

DISPOSITION (eDisposition) fields in NEMSIS 3.4.0 data

Documenting where EMS took patients allows us to correctly categorize calls outcomes and to follow the care continuum from pre-hospital care to emergency department or acute hospital inpatient care. Performance measures that use this data include AIRWAY, CARDIAC ARREST, PEDIATRIC, RESPONSE, STEMI, STROKE and TRAUMA.

TIP: Incident/Patient Disposition (eDisposition.12) 2016 data shows some EMS agencies are setting Incident/Patient Disposition default =“Cancelled”, while others default to “No Patient Found”. There should not be information for medications and other treatment/examination for “cancelled” calls or “no patient found”!!

What NEMESIS means about data collection (excerpted from NEMESIS data dictionary version 3.4.0)

Indication of when the data element is expected to be collected.

Mandatory = Must be completed and does not allow for NOT values

Required = Must be completed and allows NOT values

Recommended = Does not need to be completed and allows NOT values

Optional = Does not need to be completed and does not allow for NOT values
