Re: Online EMS Education Approval System

Effective May 1, 2020 all applications for approval of EMS education (initial and continuing) must be submitted via the new online EMS Education Approval System, located on the DPH FLIS webpage. There is a link on the OEMS Education Webpage. The direct link is: https://dphflisevents.ct.gov/EMSSystems

In accordance with Regulation §19a-179-17, applications must be submitted at least 30 days prior to the start of training programs. The system will not accept applications that fail to comply with this requirement.

This system replaces the T-1 and T-2 form, however supporting documentation must still be attached and uploaded with the submission. Such supporting documentation includes:

- medical direction approval (letter or T-3 form)
- course outline or lesson plan(s)
- syllabus and course policies
- clinical contracts, if any
- schedule, including proposed instructors
- sample course completion certificate

Once submitted, the applicant will receive a confirmation email, and after review by this office, an emailed approval letter. Should an applicant need to send additional documents, it should be done by email, not by creating a new submission.
