SUBJECT: Boy Scouts of America Recalls Neckerchief Slides Due to Violation of Federal Lead Content Ban

On September 27, 2018 the United States Consumer Product Safety Commission issued a recall for certain Boy Scouts of America neckerchief slides due to lead content.

The recalled neckerchief slides are in four styles: red wolf, green bear, orange lion and blue Webelos. "Made in China" and P.O. number 200228276, 20023175, 200233281 or 200236630 are printed on a white label attached to the back of the neckerchief slide. They were sold exclusively at Boy Scouts of America retail stores and authorized distributors nationwide and online at [www.scoutshop.org](http://www.scoutshop.org) from February 2018 through August 2018.

Consumers should immediately stop using the recalled neckerchief slides, take them away from children and return them to any Boy Scouts of America retail store or distributor for a free replacement neckerchief slide, including shipping.
