SUBJECT: Gel Spice, Inc. Issues Alert on Elevated Lead Levels in One Lot of Fresh Finds

Ground Turmeric Powder

On July 28, 2016 the U.S. Food and Drug Administration issued a recall for Fresh Finds Ground Turmeric Powder that contains elevated levels of lead that was distributed at Big Lots Stores throughout the United States. The spice is packaged in a 3.75 oz. PET jar with the code of B/B 03/08/19 and B/B 05/18/19 on the neck of the container. The package also has a UPC code of 81026-01230.

Consumers who have purchased "Fresh Finds Ground Turmeric" should discard the product. Consumers with questions about the recalled product may call (201) 564-0435.
