Examples of a Radon Partnership Plan



- Offer a radon test to every resident that comes in for permits when building a new home (we can also encourage RRNC with this approach)
- Conduct a radon test during a Healthy Homes visit or a routine complaint
- Neighborhood campaigns
- You know better how it would work best with your staff and partners...
- Admin staff could take care of the tracking and reminder calls/texts/emails





Partnership Requirements

- Tracking forms filled out
- Follow-up with residents within 10 days of receiving test devices
 - Reminder voice mails
 - Reminder emails
 - Conversations – “Have you tested yet?” “Why not?”
- Results no longer reported by LHD to community residents as the radon tests will not be from DPH lab this year
 - AirChek and RTCA devices will be bought and distributed

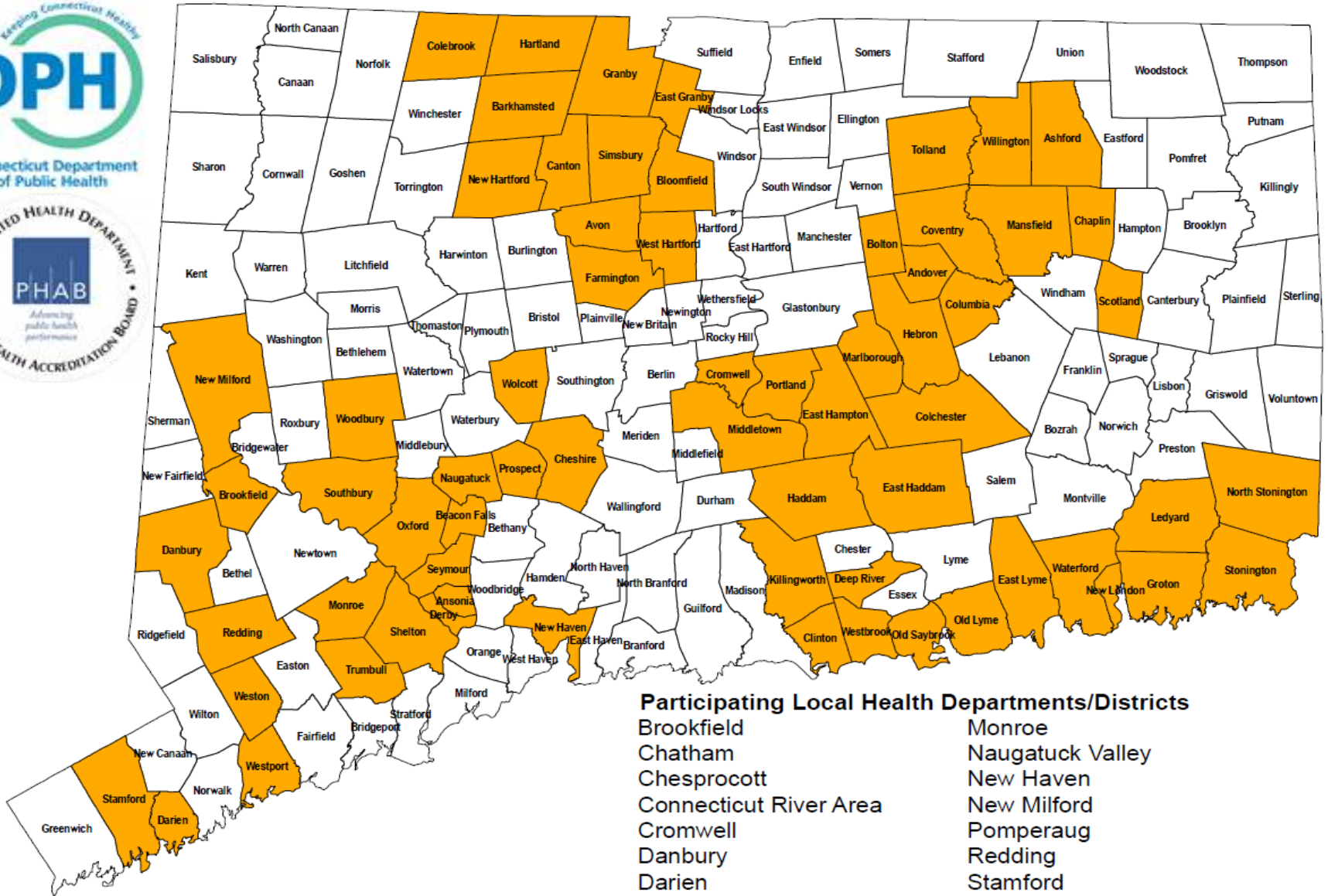


With your approved partnership project plan you will receive:

2018 Local Health - Radon Program Partnership

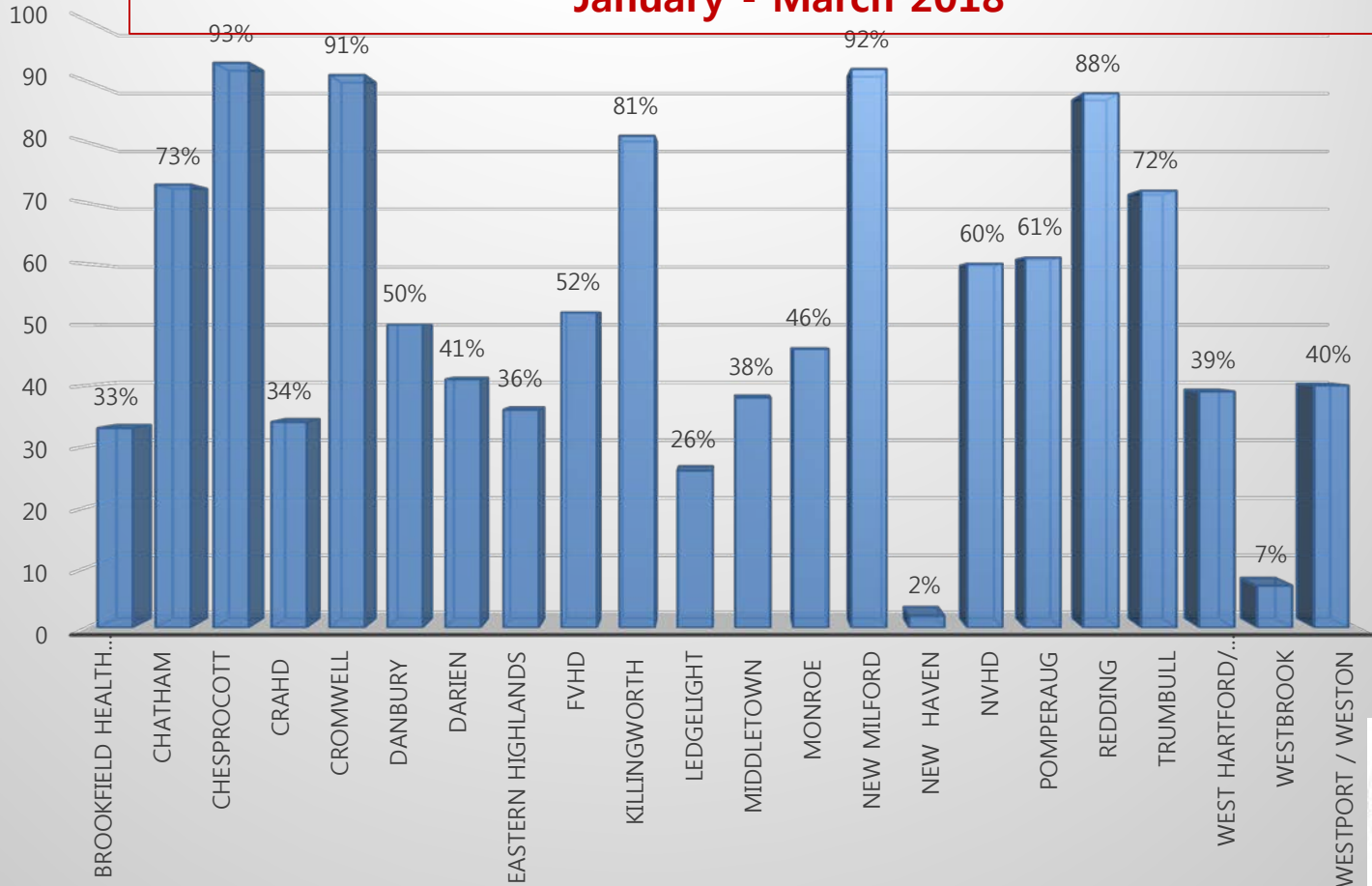
