






Asthma ED Visit Rates (0-17y)








Asthma ED Visit Rates (0-17y) by Race/Ethnicity








Asthma ED Visit Rates (0-17y) by Race/Ethnicity








Asthma ED Visit Charges (0-17y) by Race/Ethnicity

Five-Years Total Charges, 2010-2014




Asthma ED Visit Charges (0-17y) by Source of Payment







Asthma ED Visit Charges (0-17y) by Source of Payment & Race/Ethnicity




