Mission statement: The NAICP is founded to establish a forum for state and municipal adult immunization coordinators to exchange critical adult immunization information, and to provide guidance and leadership in addressing challenges to improve adult vaccination coverage rates.

Goals:

Goal: to increase awareness and uptake of adult vaccines through education of providers and the general public and implementation of programs at the local, state, and federal levels.

Goal: to assess and prioritize adult immunization issues; share adult immunization information; convey successful project ideas; discuss legislative roadblocks and successes; and use the executive committee as the foundation to encourage all grantees to adopt and implement best practices in improving adult vaccination awareness and coverage.

<u>History:</u> the NAICP Executive Committee met over the phone and decided to hold quarterly telephone meetings of all states' Adult Immunization Coordinators to discuss and share ideas, and to distribute outreach information and projects. This decision was based on input from the Adult Immunization Coordinators attending the NIC Adult Immunization Coordinators' lunch meeting in 2008.
