The **Connecticut State Board of Chiropractic Examiners** held a meeting at the Department of Health at 410 Capitol Avenue, Hartford, CT on February 21, 2019 in the third floor Hearing Room.

Dr. Carroccia called the meeting to order at 9:08 a.m.

I. <u>MINUTES</u>

Dr. Carucci made a motion, seconded by Dr. Boghosian, to approve the minutes from the December 20, 2018 meeting. The motion passed.

II. NEW BUSINESS

A. <u>Annual Approval of Chiropractic Colleges/Universities</u>

Dr. Boghosian made a motion, seconded by Ms. Carucci, that pursuant to § 20-27(d) of the Connecticut General Statutes, to approve only those colleges and universities that are accredited by the Council on Chiropractic Education. The motion passed.

Dr. Robotham called in to the meeting at 9:15 a.m.

III. OFFICE OF LICENSURE REGULATION AND COMPLIANCE

A. <u>Peter Allegra, D.C. – Petition Nos. 2017-741; 2017-1390; 2017-1400</u> Staff Attorney Diane Wilan presented to the Board a Consent Order in this matter. Dr. Carucci made a motion, seconded by Dr. Boghosian to approve the Consent Order. The motion passed with all in favor

except Dr. Robotham who recused himself from voting. Dr. Carroccia signed the order which imposes a reprimand and a \$4500.00 civil penalty.

B. Bradley Weinstein, D.C. – Petition No. 2017-183

Principal Attorney Matthew Antonetti presented to the Board a Consent Order in this matter. Dr. Boghosian made a motion, seconded by Dr. Carucci to approve the Consent Order. The motion passed with all in favor except Dr. Robotham who abstained.

Dr. Carroccia signed the order which imposes a reprimand and a \$15000.00 civil penalty.

IV FACT-FINDING

<u>Declaratory Ruling - Federal Aviation Administration - BasicMed Comprehensive Medical Examination</u> Assistant Attorney General Kerry Colson was present to provided counsel to the Board.

The Board unanimously voted that the 22 categories listed on the Comprehensive Medical Examination Checklist are taught in Chiropractic Colleges accredited by the Council on Chiropractic Education and are with the scope of practice of a chiropractor licensed in Connecticut.

Dr. Carucci made a motion, seconded by Dr. Robotham, that exercising medical discretion to address, as medically appropriate, any medical conditions identified, and to exercise medical discretion in determining whether any medical tests are warranted as part of the comprehensive medical examination is taught in Chiropractic Colleges accredited by the Council on Chiropractic Education and is with the scope of practice of a chiropractor licensed in Connecticut. The motion passed unanimously,

Dr. Carucci made a motion, seconded by Dr. Carroccia, that the discussion of all drugs an individual reports taking (prescription and nonprescription) and their potential to interfere with the safe operation of an aircraft or motor vehicle with the scope of practice of a chiropractor licensed in Connecticut. The motion passed unanimously.

Dr. Carucci made a motion, seconded by Dr. Carroccia that it is within the scope of practice of chiropractor licensed in Connecticut to perform the Federal Aviation Administration BasicMed comprehensive medical examination as set forth in 14 C.F.R. §§ 61.23, 68.5 and 68.7.

Dr. Carroccia, Dr. Carucci and Dr. Robotham voted in favor of this motion. Dr. Boghosian was opposed.

V. <u>ADJOURN</u>

The meeting was adjourned at 10:20 a.m. on motion by Dr. Robotham, seconded by Dr. Carucci.
