#### I. <u>MINUTES</u>

The minutes from the September 4, 2019 meeting were reviewed and unanimously approved on a motion by Dr. Reiss, seconded by Ms. Ulrich.

# II. <u>NEW BUSINESS</u>

#### A. Reinstatement after practicing with a lapsed license

Stephen Carragher, Public Health Services Manager, DPH Practitioner Licensing Unit explained the current policy regarding practitioners who have continued to practice after their license has expired and are seeking reinstatement. The current policy requires a reinstatement consent order which imposes a reprimand and a civil penalty which is calculated based on the time period the practitioner has continued to practice.

Mr. Zager made a Motion, seconded by Dr. Reiss to endorse DPH's current policy. The motion passed unanimously.

# B. <u>Provisional License Application - Patricia Arcos Villalva, DDS</u>

Judith Bailey, License and Applications Analyst, Department of Public Health presented a provisional license application for Patricia Arcos Villalva, DDS, to allow for practice at the University of Connecticut, School of Dental Medicine. Following review of the application Dr. Reiss made a motion, seconded by Mr. Zager, to recommend provisional licensure for Dr. <u>Villalva</u>. The motion passed unanimously.

# III. OFFICE OF LEGAL COMPLIANCE

A. Yelena taran, DDS - Petition No. 2017-1403

David Tilles, Staff Attorney, Department of Public Health presented a Consent Order in this matter. Respondent was not present or represented.

Dr. Reiss made a motion, seconded by Ms. Ulrich, to approve the Consent Order which imposes a reprimand and a \$5000.00 civil penalty. The motion passed unanimously. Dr. Katz signed the Order.
