V. **NEW BUSINESS**

Judith Bailey, License & Application Analyst, presented a License Reinstatement Review for Kathleen French. The board recommends that Kathleen French comply with the continuing education of at least the required amount per year of 10 hours, including sterilization, and thereafter takes and passes the current practical exam.
