This act expands the circumstances under which funeral directors and embalmers are protected from disciplinary actions based on the invalidation of their national board examination score. Under prior law, if a licensee with such an invalidated score failed to retake and pass the exam by October 1, 2018, his or her license was annulled. Under this act, this penalty applies if the licensee fails to retake the exam by that date or complete the 45 hours of continuing education by July 1, 2019.

Mr. Andresen reported that 18 licensees have been affected by the invalidation of their examination scores. Thus far 6 of those 18 have retaken and passed the examination. The remaining individuals have the option of retaking the exam by October 1, 2108 or completing the continuing education by July 1, 2019.
