CONNECTICUT MEDICAL EXAMINING BOARD MINUTES of May 21, 2019

The Connecticut Medical Examining Board held a meeting on Tuesday, May 21, 2019 at the Department of Public Health Complex, 410-470 Capitol Avenue, Hartford, Connecticut in conference room 470 C.

Ms. Emmett called the meeting to order at 1:33 p.m.

Dr. Sauer was welcomed to his first meeting as a member of the Board. Dr. Sauer was appointed by Governor Lamont on May 7, 2019.

Dr. Rissi made a motion, seconded by Dr. Wolf, recommending that Dr. Kaye's license reinstatement be approved. The motion unanimously.

A. James Bucci, MD - Petition No. 2017-1049

Staff Attorney David Tilles, Department of Public Health, presented a Consent Order in this matter. Attorney Gregory Gagne was present on behalf of respondent.

Mr. McAnaney made a motion, seconded by Ms. Ekonomides, to adopt the Consent Order as written.

Following discussion Mr. McAnaney and Dr. Katz voted in favor of approval, Dr. Sauer abstained and all others were opposed. The motion failed.

B. Danielle Donfrancesco (Unlicensed), Petition No. 2018-472

Staff Attorney Brittany Allen, Department of Public Health, presented a Consent Order in this matter. Respondent was not present and was not represented.

Dr. Wolf made a motion, seconded by Ms. Rexford, to adopt the Cease and Desist Consent Order as written. The motion passed with all in favor except Dr. Green who was opposed and Dr. Sauer who abstained.

Ms. Emmett signed the Order which requires respondent to cease and desist the practice of medicine.

C. <u>Gayle Klein, MD - Petition No. 2018-695</u>

Matthew Antonetti, Principal Attorney, Department of Public Health, presented a Consent Order in this matter. Respondent was present with Attorney Stewart Johnson.

Dr. Rissi made a motion, seconded by Ms. Ekonomides, to adopt the Consent Order as written. The motion passed with all in favor except Dr. Sauer who abstained. Ms. Emmett signed the Order which imposes a reprimand and probation for a period of one year.

D. Thomas Knox, MD - Petition No. 2015-1045

Staff Attorney Brittany Allen, Department of Public Health, presented a Consent Order in this matter. Respondent was not present and was not represented.

Mr. McAnaney made a motion, seconded by Ms. Jacklin, to adopt the Consent Order as written. The motion passed with all in favor except Dr. Katz and Dr. Sauer who abstained, and Dr. Rissi and Dr. Wolf who were recused. Ms. Emmett signed the Order which imposes a reprimand.

E. Mark Scanlon, MD - Petition No. 2015-1045

Matthew Antonetti, Principal Attorney, Department of Public Health, presented a Consent Order in this matter. Attorney Ellen Costello was present on behalf of respondent.

Dr. Rissi made a motion, seconded by Dr. Wolf, to adopt the Consent Order as written. The motion passed with all in favor except Ms. Jacklin who was opposes, Dr. Sauer who abstained, and Dr. Green who was recused. Ms. Emmett signed the Order which imposes a \$5000.00 civil penalty.

F. Andrew Swan, MD - Petition No. 2018-900

Matthew Antonetti, Principal Attorney, Department of Public Health, presented a Consent Order in this matter. Attorney Ellen Costello was present on behalf of respondent.

Mr. McAnaney made a motion, seconded by Dr. Wolf, to adopt the Consent Order as written. The motion passed with all in favor except Dr. Sauer who abstained. Ms. Emmett signed the Order which imposes a reprimand and a \$7500.00 civil penalty.

G. Dale Wallington, MD - Petition No. 2017-1155

Staff Attorney David Tilles, Department of Public Health, presented a Consent Order in this matter. Attorney Richard Tynan was present on behalf of respondent.

Dr. Rissi made a motion, seconded by Mr. Andrews, to adopt the Consent Order as written. The motion passed with all in favor except Dr. Katz Dr. Sauer who abstained. Ms. Emmett signed the Order which imposes a reprimand, a \$7500.00 civil penalty and probation for a period of eighteen months.
