#### CONNECTICUT MEDICAL EXAMINING BOARD MINUTES of September 17, 2019

The Connecticut Medical Examining Board held a meeting on Tuesday, September 17, 2019 at the Legislative Office Building, 300 Capitol Avenue, Hartford, Connecticut in conference room 1-A.

Ms. Emmett called the meeting to order at 1:30 p.m.

### I. <u>MINUTES</u>

The draft minutes of the July 16, 2019 meeting were reviewed. Dr. Green made a motion, seconded by Dr. Sauer to approve the minutes. The motion passed with all in favor.

The Board was informed that pursuant to Section 20-13e of the Connecticut General Statutes, investigations of complaints against a physician shall be confidential unless the physician requests that such investigation and disclosure be open or if formal charges have been filed by the Department. Therefore it cannot be acknowledged if such a complaint was reported.

# IV. <u>NEW BUSINESS</u>

A. <u>Reinstatement after practicing with a lapsed license</u>

Stephen Carragher, Public Health Services Manager, DPH Practitioner Licensing Unit explained the current policy regarding practitioners who have continued to practice after their license has expired and are seeking reinstatement. The current policy requires a reinstatement consent order which imposes a reprimand and a civil penalty which is calculated based on the time period the practitioner has continued to practice.

Dr. Sauer made a Motion, seconded by Dr. Yuan to endorse DPH's current policy/ The motion passed unanimously.

## B. <u>Ashel Sanchez-Mitchell, MD – Review of License Reinstatement Application</u>

Celeste Dowdell, License and Applications Analyst, Department of Public Health presented a license reinstatement application for Ashel Sanchez-Mitchell, MD.

Dr. Green made a motion, seconded by Dr. Eugene, recommending that Dr. Sanchez-Mitchell's license reinstatement be approved. The motion unanimously.

## C. Martin Bernard, MD – Review of License Reinstatement Application

Celeste Dowdell, License and Applications Analyst, Department of Public Health presented a license reinstatement application for Martin Bernard, MD.

Dr. Sauer made a motion, seconded by Mr. Andrews, recommending that Dr. Bernard's license reinstatement be approved. The motion unanimously.

# V. OFFICE OF LEGAL COMPLIANCE

A. Lycyna Kolakowsi, MD - Petition No. 2018-765

Principal Attorney Matthew Antonetti, Department of Public Health, presented a Consent Order in this matter. Attorney John Barberi was present with respondent.

Dr. Wolf made a motion, seconded by Dr. Patel, to adopt this Consent Order as written. The motion passed unanimously.

Ms. Emmett signed the Order which imposes a reprimand, probation for seven months, and a \$5000.00 civil penalty.

B. Jane Srinivasan, MD - Petition No. 2018-716

Staff Attorney Brittany Allen, Department of Public Health, presented a Consent Order in this matter. Respondent and her attorney were not present.

Dr. Rissi made a motion, seconded by Ms. Ekonomides, to adopt the Consent Order as written. The motion passed with all in favor except Ms. Jacklin who was opposed and Dr. Green who recused himself from voting. Ms. Emmett signed the Order which imposes a practice restriction prohibiting respondent from performing surgery.

C. Constance Tambakis-Odom, MD - Petition No. 2018-1380

Principal Attorney Matthew Antonetti, Department of Public Health, presented a Consent Order in this matter. Respondent was not present and was not represented by counsel.

Dr. Wolf made a motion, seconded by Dr. Patel, to adopt the Consent Order as written. The motion passed unanimously. Ms. Emmett signed the Order which imposes a reprimand.

D. Christine Cornachio, MD – Petition No. 2019-649

Staff Attorney Linda Fazzina, Department of Public Health, presented a Consent Order in this matter. Respondent was not present and was not represented by counsel.

Dr. Green made a motion, seconded by Dr. Sauer, to adopt the Consent Order as written. The motion passed except Dr. Duffy who was abstained. Ms. Emmett signed the Order which imposes probation for a period of five years.
