IV. NEW BUSINESS

A. Review of Criteria for use of the Federation of State Medical Board SPEX Examination Stephen Carragher, Health Program Supervisor, Department of Public Health, Office of Practitioner License and Certification was present for this discussion.

A work group of Board members and DPH staff will meet before a future Board meeting to further discuss this topic.

B. <u>Investigation and Discipline of Sexual Misconduct Allegations</u>

Assistant Attorney General Henry Salton was present for this discussion and Christian Andresen Section Chief, Department of Public Health were present for this discussion. Mr. Andresen indicated that the Department of Public Health will reach out to licensed facilities regarding the duty to report any incidents/allegations that may reflect on a physician's ability to practice with reasonable skill and safety.

C. <u>Interstate Licensure Compact</u>

Assistant Attorney General Henry Salton and Christian Andresen Section Chief, Department of Public Health were present for this discussion.

Mr. Andresen commented that the Department of Public Health and the Connecticut State Medical Society are in discussions regarding this issue.

D. Request for License Reinstatement Hearing - John Lynch II, MD

Assistant Attorney General Henry Salton was present for this discussion. Petitioner was present but not represented.

Dr. Rissi made a motion, seconded by Dr. Green, to grant Dr. Lynch's request for a hearing to determine if his license, revoked on June 20, 2012, should be reinstated. The motion passed unanimously.

E. Wendy Amblo MD – Review of License Application

Stephen Carragher, Health Program Supervisor, Department of Public Health presented a license reinstatement application for Wendy Amblo MD.

Dr. Green made a motion, seconded by Dr. Yuan recommending that Dr. Amblo's license reinstatement be approved. The motion passed with all in favor except Dr. Rissi, Dr. Wolf and Dr. Patel who were opposed.

V. OFFICE OF LEGAL COMPLIANCE

A. David Landi (Unlicensed) - Petition No. 2018-957

Mathew Antonetti, Principal Attorney, Department of Public Health, presented a Consent Order in this matter. Respondent and his attorney were not present.

Dr. Green made a motion, seconded by Sr. Wolf, to adopt the Cease and Desist Consent Order as written. The motion passed unanimously.

Ms. Emmett signed the Order which requires respondent to cease and desist the practice of medicine.

B. Francis Walsh, M.D., Petition No. 2016-947

Staff Attorney David Tilles, Department of Public Health, presented a Consent Order in this matter. Attorney Michael Stanton was present on behalf of respondent.

Dr. Rissi made a motion, seconded by Dr. Katz, to adopt the Consent Order as written. The motion passed with all in favor except Ms. Jacklin and Ms. Rexford who were opposed. Ms. Emmett signed the Order which imposes a reprimand, a \$3000.00 civil penalty and probation for a period of six months.
