IV. PRESENTATION - HEALTH ASSISTANCE INTERVENTION EDUCATION NETWORK

Maureen Dinnan, Executive provided an annual update regarding the Haven Program and the services offered to participants. Ms. Dinnan reported that referrals to HAVEN have increased by 54% from 2015 through 2019. At the end of 2019 there were 332 active participants in the program. 157 individuals were new to the program in 2019, of which 44 are physicians and 4 are physician assistants.

A. James Montuorri, DO – Review of License Reinstatement Application

Celeste Dowdell, License and Applications Analyst, Department of Public Health presented a license reinstatement application for James Montuorri, DO.

Dr. Green made a motion, seconded by Mr. McAnaney, recommending that Dr. Montuorri's license reinstatement be approved. The motion passed unanimously.

B. <u>Proposed Memorandum of Decision re; License Reinstatement</u> John Lynch, MD

Assistant Attorney General Daniel Shapiro was present to provide counsel to the Board. Staff Attorney David Tilles was present for the Department of Public Health. Dr. Lynch was present with Attorney James Biondo.

The Board reviewed the proposed Memorandum of Decision in this matter and heard comments from Attorney Tilles and Attorney Biondo.

Mr. Andrews made a motion, seconded by Ms. Ekonomides, to adopt the Memorandum of Decision as amended. The motion passed with all in favor except Dr. London and Dr. Zeman who recused themselves from voting.

Ms. Emmett signed the Order which reinstates Dr. Lynch's license with conditions.

VI. OFFICE OF LEGAL COMPLIANCE

A. Cheryl McDonald, PA - Petition No. 2017-1495

Staff Attorney Brittany Allen, Department of Public Health, presented a Consent Order in this matter. Attorney Jonathan Kocienda was present with respondent.

Dr. Rissi made a motion, seconded by Mr. McAnaney, to adopt the Consent Order as written. The motion passed unanimously. Ms. Emmett signed the Order which imposes a \$2,500.00 civil penalty.

B. Sundaramurthy Balachandran, MD - Petition No. 2019-486

Staff Attorney Brittany Allen, Department of Public Health, presented a Consent Order in this matter. Respondent was not present and was not represented by counsel.

Mr. McAnaney made a motion, seconded by Ms. Ekonomides, to adopt the Consent Order as written. The motion passed unanimously. Ms. Emmett signed the Order which imposes a \$1,000.00 civil penalty.

C. David Marks, M.D. - Petition No. 2016-791

Staff Attorney David Tilles, Department of Public Health, presented a Consent Order in this matter. Attorney Michael Neubert was present with respondent.

Dr. Zeman made a motion, seconded by Dr. Green, to adopt the Consent Order as written. The motion passed unanimously. Ms. Emmett signed the Order which imposes a reprimand, a \$7,500.00 civil penalty, and probation for one year.
