

Minutes

By authority of the General Statutes of Connecticut, Sections 4-177 and 20-8a, a contested case hearing was held remotely via Microsoft Teams on Monday, August 5, 2024, before a panel of the Connecticut Medical Examining Board, consisting of: Peter Zeman, MD, Robert Green, MD, and Raymond Andrews, Esq., in the matter of:

David K. Israel, MD, Petition No. 2023-1187.

The proceedings were digitally recorded.

Respondent appeared. Staff Attorney Joelle Newton appeared on behalf of the Department.

The hearing convened at 10:18 a.m. with Dr. Peter Zeman presiding, advised by Assistant Attorney General Elizabeth Bannon.

At 11:06 a.m., Dr. Peter Zeman, Dr. Robert Green, and Attorney Raymond Andrews unanimously agreed to enter into Executive Session for the purpose of discussing confidential medical information. The Board Panel returned to the public meeting at 11:09 a.m. No motions were made, and no votes were taken during Executive Session. The following individuals attended the Executive Session: all members of the Board Panel, Assistant Attorney General Elizabeth Bannon, Respondent David K. Israel, Department Attorney Joelle Newton, Board Liaison Betty J. Rozario and the court reporter.

At 12:40 p.m., Dr. Peter Zeman moved to enter into Executive Session for the purpose of discussing confidential medical information. Dr. Robert Green and Attorney Raymond Andrews seconded the motion. The Board Panel returned to the public meeting at 12:56 p.m. No motions were made, and no votes were taken during Executive Session. The following individuals attended the Executive Session: all members of the Board Panel, Assistant Attorney General Elizabeth Bannon, Respondent David K. Israel, Department Attorney Joelle Newton, Board Liaison Betty J. Rozario and the court reporter.

Following the close of the hearing the Board Panel conducted fact-finding. Dr. Peter Zeman made a motion, seconded by Attorney Raymond Andrews, that Respondent's discipline be revocation of his medical license. The motion passed unanimously.

Dr. Peter Zeman moved to vote in favor of revocation of Respondent's license. Attorney Raymond Andrews and Dr. Robert Green voted in favor of the motion. The motion was approved unanimously.

Dr. Peter Zeman adjourned the hearing at 2:57 p.m.
