II. OFFICE OF LEGAL COMPLIANCE

B. Anthony Rao, OD – Petition No. 2018-667

Staff Attorney Joelle Newton, Department of Public Health, presented a Consent Order in this matter. Attorney Stephanie Sobkowiak was present on behalf of Dr. Rao.

Ms. Goldberg made a motion, seconded by Ms. Barrett, to approve the Consent Order as written. The motion passed with all in favor. Dr. Blondin signed the Order which imposes a reprimand and a \$9500.00 civil penalty.

The motion passed with all in favor.
