I. MINUTES

The Board reviewed the minutes of the meeting of June 10, 2019. Dr. Horn moved, and Dr. Oakes seconded, that the minutes be approved. The motion passed.

II. New Business

A. Reinstatement after practicing with a lapsed license

Deborah Brown, DPH Practitioner Licensing Unit explained the current policy regarding practitioners who have continued to practice after their license has expired and are seeking reinstatement. The current policy requires a reinstatement consent order which imposes a reprimand and a civil penalty which is calculated based on the time period the practitioner has continued to practice.

Mr. Colangelo made a motion, seconded by Dr. Campagna, to endorse the DPH's current policy. The motion passed unanimously.

III. OFFICE OF LEGAL COMPLAINCE

Evelyn Bettauer, PhD - Petition No. 2018-317

Linda Fazzina, Staff Attorney, Department of Public Health presented a Cease and Desist Consent Order in the matter of John M. Gonzalez. Respondent was present with Attorney Jonathan Kocienda.

Dr. Campagna made a motion, seconded by Dr. Oakes, to approve the Consent Order which imposes a reprimand, a \$2500.00 civil penalty, and probation for a period of one year. The motion passed unanimously.

The Board requests that the proposed order be modified by adding language requiring respondent to contact internet advertisers to remove his name from advertisements.
