- 2. As a result of concerns related to respondent's clinical care, respondent underwent a neuropsychological fitness for duty examination on or about May 14, 2021 and/or May 19, 2021, which indicates mental illness, emotional disorder, and/or cognitive deficits.
- 3. Respondent's physical or mental illness, emotional disorder, and/or loss of motor skill, including but not limited to, deterioration through the aging process, does, and/or may, affect her practice as a psychologist.
- 4. The above facts constitute grounds for disciplinary action pursuant to the General Statutes of Connecticut, §20-192, including but not limited to suffering from mental illness and/or an emotional disorder.

- 2. As a result of concerns related to respondent's clinical care, respondent underwent a neuropsychological fitness for duty examination on or about May 14, 2021 and/or May 19, 2021, which indicates mental illness, emotional disorder, and/or cognitive deficits.
- 3. Respondent's physical or mental illness, emotional disorder, and/or loss of motor skill, including but not limited to, deterioration through the aging process, does, and/or may, affect her practice as a psychologist.
- 4. The above facts constitute grounds for disciplinary action pursuant to the General Statutes of Connecticut, §20-192, including but not limited to suffering from mental illness and/or an emotional disorder.

THEREFORE, the Department prays that:

The Connecticut Board of Examiners of Psychologists, as authorized by the General Statutes of Connecticut, §§20-192 and 19a-17, revoke or order other disciplinary action against the license of Rachel Sampson Psy.D. as it deems appropriate and consistent with law.
