Welcome and Introductions Report of Subgroups and Discussion of Strategy Evidence		<ul> <li>Asthma (CD-16) Subgroup found that there was evidence to support all of the strategies.</li> <li>Oral Health(CD -22) Subgroup found there was evidence to support all of the strategies except the one focused on advocacy for parity of oral health with physical and behavioral health (medical) in practice, policy and reimbursement. The Subgroup chose to develop a strategy additional to the one on sealants that would address fluoride varnish.</li> <li>The Obesity (CD-27) Subgroup recommended the first strategy under Advocacy and Policy regarding review and revision of local/school wellness policy to be deleted as it was not written factually and a portion is already in process. The Subgroup found there to be evidence to support most remaining strategies except were unsure with regard to advocacy for universal screening for overweight and obesity in schools. The Subgroup will recommend some new language for the strategy on healthy food options in vending machines.</li> </ul>	

	The Tobacco Subgroup had two tasks before it and had discussed a need to broaden strategies to address tobacco products. It had begun to assess supportive evidence.
