Challenges and Possible Solutions

Recruiting and expanding subgroups

- Identify whether any recommendations have a clear target

- Continue to monitor whether students/ interns can assist

2017 Focus Initiative (s): Selection Considerations

Strategic	Systemic	Broad Geo Reach	Health Equity
Consider whether the strategy is feasible, sufficient resources are available, there is momentum and there is a value-add from Action Team involvement	Consider whether there is a policy, systems and/or environmental (PSE) change involved and actions can be identified at multiple-levels (e.g. state, local, organizational) and settings (eg. school, healthcare, worksites)	Consider whether there is a PSE change and whether and how initiative can reach multiple communities	Consider whether there is a PSE change, define the disparity being addressed, and how disparate populations or organizations that represent/reach these populations are engaged.
