Welcome, purpose, and introductions	The purpose of the first pre-summit planning meeting is to assess what worked and what didn't work in the process up to this point.
Overview of background and purpose of SHIP and Action Agenda	The SHIP was collaboratively developed by health partners across the state and released in 2014. In 2015, partners re-convened into Focus Area Action Teams to narrow down the focus for the first year of implementation in the form of the 2016 Action Agenda. Many of the action teams discovered that their plans may have been mismatched to the current capacity of coalition partners. In 2017, SHIP Action Teams are being asked to prioritize and streamline initiatives to better manage progress. Groups are also being asked to consider layering their strategies similar to the structure of the National Prevention Strategies; identifying opportunities for local communities, statewide networks, and state level organizations.
Overview of September     Planning Meeting	The SHIP Action Summit is scheduled for 09-08-2016. This will be a full day meeting including the full SHIP Coalition membership. During this event there will be recognition for 2016 accomplishments. There will also be a breakout session for each of the action teams to finalize 2017 Action Agenda plans. Discuss challenges, gaps, and lessons learned (what are our weaknesses?)	<ul> <li>Challenges identified by the group included:</li> <li>Lack of funding for expansion strategies</li> <li>Lack of continuity in action committee participation</li> <li>Need for greater diversity in representation of at risk populations</li> <li>Difficult for clinical members to participate in conference calls or meetings due to time constraints of clinic schedule</li> <li>Not everyone who needs a voice has a voice at the table</li> <li>Action items tended to focus on DPH – need to think more broadly about how local health districts and non-government partners can leverage relationships and expand the reach of the group</li> <li>Original action plan may have been over ambitious</li> <li>Current budget climate</li> <li>Lessons learned:</li> <li>Improvements take time and money</li> <li>Shared resources and partnerships are beneficial to improving outcomes for a greater number of residents</li> <li>Communication is key</li> </ul>
