- Adapting the campaign for adolescents talking with colleagues in RI who have adapted curriculum for High School and working with Brown University to scale down to Middle School
- Next in-person training will be mid-June
- Leadership council scheduled for this summer have identified two new male members who have experience working with and reaching out to LGBT populations
